### Macon County Current Epidemiological Situation:

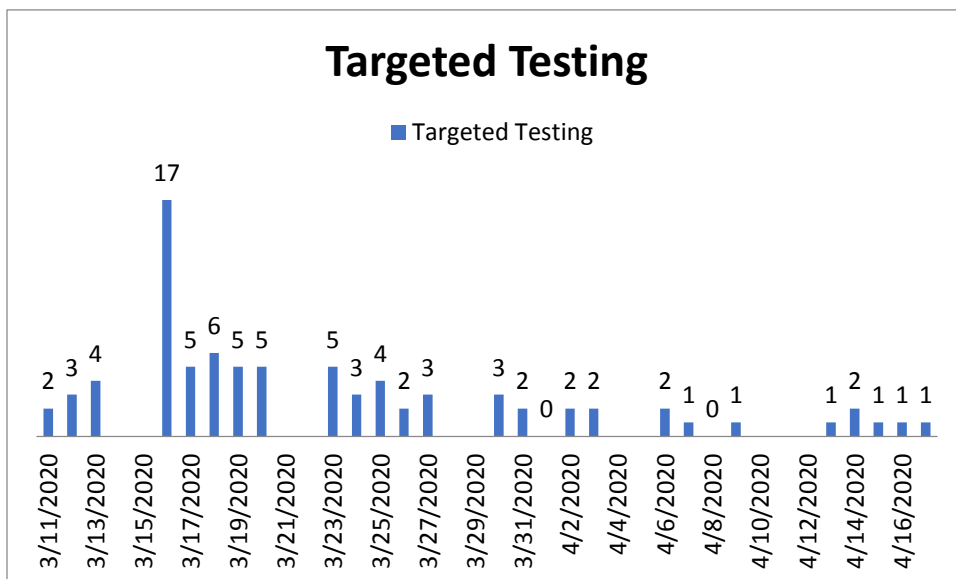
- Current
  - 83 Targeted Tests Performed by MCPH
  - 4 Person Under Investigation (test results pending)
  - 83 Targeted Tests, 79 testing negative
- Past
  - 1 Presumptive case, confirmatory testing pending (NY resident)- Release from Isolation 3/26/20
  - 2 Returned Travelers under Quarantine (Released 4/5/20)
  - 1 Positive Macon County Resident (Tested out of County) (now deceased)
  - 1 Positive Macon County Resident (Tested out of State) (Recovered 4/14/20)

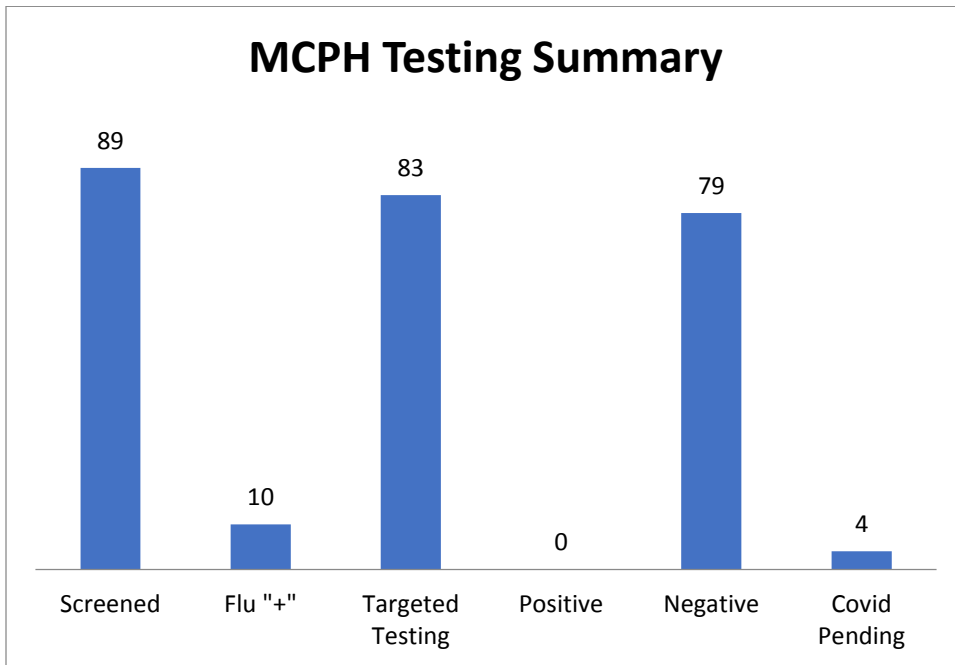
### Targeted Testing Performed at MCPH (Does not include tests performed by outside providers or hospitals):

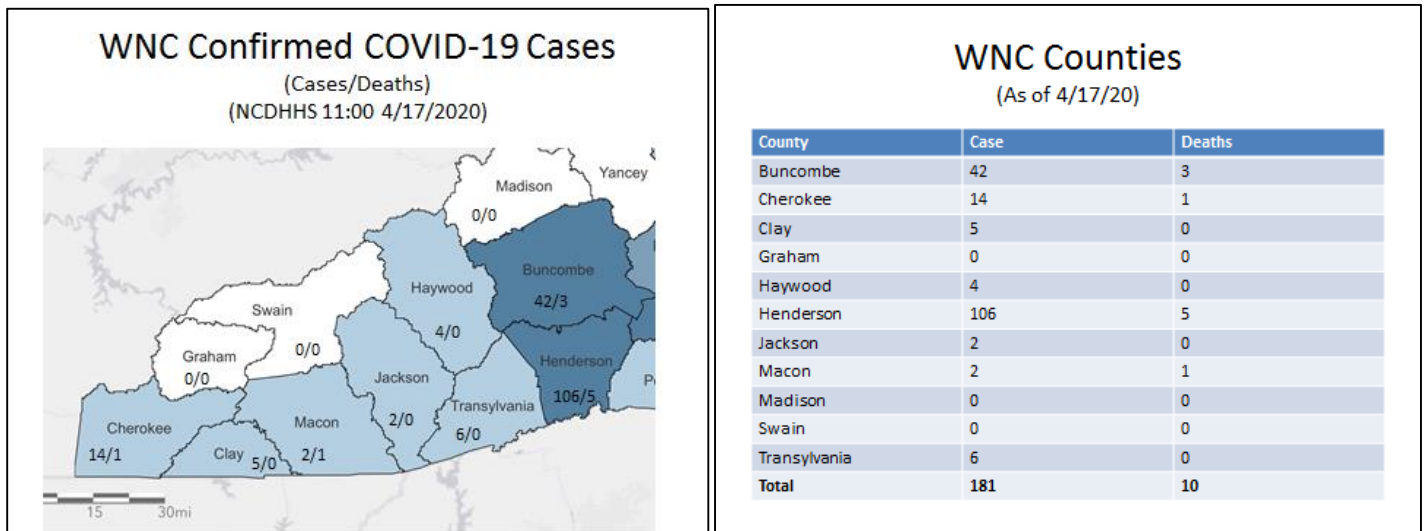

**Weather: NOAA - As of 4/17/20**

**Today**

Sunny, with a high near 68. Light south wind increasing to 8 to 13 mph in the morning. Winds could gust as high as 20 mph.

**Tonight**

Rain likely, mainly after 5am. Increasing clouds, with a low around 48. South wind 5 to 7 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New precipitation amounts of less than a tenth of an inch possible.

**Saturday**

A chance of showers before 11am, then a slight chance of rain between 11am and noon. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 68. Northwest wind 5 to 8 mph. Chance of precipitation is 40%. New precipitation amounts of less than a tenth of an inch possible.

**Saturday Night**

Mostly clear, with a low around 39. Light and variable wind.

**Sunday**

Showers, with thunderstorms also possible after 5pm. High near 65. Calm wind becoming south around 6 mph in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation is 80%.

**Sunday Night**

Showers and possibly a thunderstorm before 3am, then showers likely. Low around 49. Chance of precipitation is 90%.

**Monday**

A 30 percent chance of showers before 2pm. Partly sunny, with a high near 68.



**Monday Night**

Mostly clear, with a low around 40.

**Tuesday**

Sunny, with a high near 70.

**Tuesday Night**

Mostly clear, with a low around 42.

**Wednesday**

Mostly sunny, with a high near 74.

**Wednesday Night**

A 40 percent chance of showers. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 51.

**Thursday**

Showers and possibly a thunderstorm. High near 69. Chance of precipitation is 80%.
