Welcome and Introduction of Guests	Teresa Breedlove welcomed everyone to today's meeting of the Chronic Disease Committee. Ms. Breedlove asked Kathy McGaha to introduce today's guests and inform the committee members of today's schedule.		
	Ms. McGaha introduced today's guests – Jennifer Stuart and Sally Smith. Ms. Stuart is the Librarian in the Health Sciences Library at MAHEC. Ms. Smith is also with MAHEC and represents WNC Health Network and WNC Healthy Kids.		
Setting up Google Accounts	Jennifer Stuart explained that if the committee members did not already have a Google account they would need to first sign up for one. Ms. Stuart led the committee members through this process.

WNC Healthy Kids	Jennifer Stuart briefly explained the history of this project. Ms. Stuart stated that a group of regional partners gathered to discuss regional ways to prevent and reduce childhood obesity. This group started the Regional Obesity Project.		
	Ms. McGaha reminded the committee members of the three regional strategies of this project: 1. A regional database of obesity efforts 2. A consistent measurement of BMI's throughout the region 3. A weight management referral resource

MCPHC Reports	Jennifer Hollifield updated the committee members on		
	the following MCPHC programs:		
	1. Diabetes Program – Ms. Hollifield reported that		
	the program has started. Kay Hilty is currently		

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	meeting with patients. Ms. Hollifield stated that		
	Ms. Hilty has completely booked the month of		
	January and is starting to fill up February.		
	2. Statewide Smoking Ban – Ms. Hollifield stated		
	that the statewide smoking ban went into effect		
	on January 2 nd . Ms. Hollifield reported that so far		
	no complaints had been reported in Macon		
	County.		
	3. Walk to Jerusalem – Ms. Hollifield reported that		
	four churches were participating in this program.		
	The churches are:		
	a. First Methodist Church		
	b. Watauga Baptist Church		
	c. Holly Springs Baptist Church		
	d. Iotla Baptist Church		
	4. Ladies Night Out – Ms. Hollifield stated that		
	three programs have been held. Ms. Hollifield stated that the January program will focus on how		
	to achieve New Year's Resolutions.		
	5. Macon County Heart Health Walk – Ms.		
	Hollifield explained that this will be a 1-mile		
	walk around downtown Franklin on February		
	13th. The walk will start and end at Tartan Hall		
	with a healthy meal being offered after the walk.		
	6. Prevention Rx – Ms. Hollifield said this program		
	is up and going. Ms. Hollifield said the focus for		
	this quarter would be tobacco cessation.		
	7. Tri-Fit Body Age Assessment Equipment – Ms.		
	Hollifield stated this equipment will be loan from		
	Be Active Appalachian Partnership from January		
	25 th to mid-April. Ms. Hollifield stated there will		
	be a training session for this equipment on		
	February 2 nd .		
	8. TRU Clubs – Ms. Hollifield stated that the TRU		
	Clubs hope to participate in the Great American		
	Spit Out Day in February.		

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	9. Girls on the Run – Ms. Hollifield said this		
	program had completed with a regional run held		
	in Asheville on December 12 th . Ms. Hollifield		
	said that South Macon School will try and keep		
	this program going.		
	10. BMI Data – Ms. Hollifield said she had compiled		
	all the BMI data from the recent School Health		
	Fairs. She stated this data would be ready to		
	review at the next meeting.		
Warmth in Winter	Kathy McGaha informed the committee members that		
	this event will be held on January 27 th , from 4:00 PM –		
	8:00 PM at CARENET. Ms. McGaha explained that this		
	project is targeted to help those in our community who		
	are homeless or are having a tough time in this economy.		
	Ms. McGaha stated a hot meal will be offered and items		
	such as clothing and personal hygiene products will be		
	passed out. She also said local agencies such as Social		
	Services, Medication Assistance and Macon Program for		
	Progress will be on hand to answer questions. Ms.		
	McGaha said transportation to this event is being		
	provided by Macon Transit.		
	Ms. McGaha said donations are currently being accepted		
	at CARENET for items such as blankets, children coats,		
	gloves, socks and hats. Personal hygiene products such		
	as deodorant and chapstick are also being accepted.

	Booth at next year's School Health Fairs. Ms.

	cover this part of the health fair, but were not		
	really successful. Ms. Garrett asked the		

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	committee members for ideas and suggestions for		
	next year.
