Aging	on Aging. Ms. McGaha stated that last year an		
	assessment was done in Macon County to gather		
	information on Livable and Senior-Friendly		
	Communities.		
	Ms. McGaha said one of the topics covered in this		
	assessment was housing situations in Macon County and		
	lack thereof. The committee members listed some of the		
	comments on the local housing situation:		
	Need for assisted living facilities		
	Need for retirement communities		
	Need for more affordable housing		
	Need for handicapped accessible housing		

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	Ms. McGaha also explained that a County Plan on Aging had also been done last year. Ms. McGaha explained that this document was a proposed Area Plan on Aging for 2008-2012. Ms. McGaha said Senior Friendly Housing and Communities was listed as objective in this plan.		
Senior Friendly Development Discussion with Guests	Kathy McGaha next led the committee members and invited guests on a group discussion of Senior Friendly Development in our county. Ms. McGaha also invited today's guests to participate in this discussion.		
	Ms. McGaha asked everyone to consider whether being certified as "Senior Friendly" would be good for businesses and the community as a whole. Ms. McGaha asked for their opinions and suggestions.		
	Everyone agreed that the previous list of the local housing situation was correct for Macon County in needing things such as affordable housing, retirement communities, more assisted living facilities and more handicapped accessible housing.		
	The main question for this group was whether being certified as "Senior Friendly" would involve a cost and what guidelines would need to be followed to be certified. Ms. McGaha said she was not sure but would check on this information and report back to this committee. Sara Melton also volunteered to investigate this topic further and report back at the next meeting.	Kathy McGaha and Sara Melton will investigate what guidelines are involved with becoming "Senior Friendly" and what costs are involved.	
	Teresa Murray questioned if other surrounding counties had this particular certification or something similar to it. Ms. Melton said she was aware that Haywood County had promoted this topic. Ms. Melton also stated that Haywood County had received a grant in the past to do this.
