	Mr. Westerman stated that one problem they currently have is availability of specific information requested by most grants. This needed information is the number of homeless in Macon County. He also stated that definitions of homelessness varies too.		
	Ms. McGaha asked the committee members if this homeless issue and gathering of homeless numbers were something this committee wanted to undertake. The		
	committee members thought homelessness was a current issue in Macon County and would be increasing.
