Homeless Count Event	 Kathy McGaha first gave a brief review of the events leading up to the Homeless Count Event held at CARENET on January 27th. Ms. McGaha complimented all the committee members for their hard work on this event. Ms. McGaha led the committee members into a group discussion on the Homeless Count Event: Location – CARENET worked out excellent as the host location for this event. Flow – The flow of the event worked out well. The committee members suggested that all organizations be in open area with a private conference available if needed. Transportation – The transit bus was very busy at first and then had very few riders the rest of the night. The committee members agreed to review this issue before this event next year. Donations – Ms. Bailey said plenty of donations had been received: especially with the donations of coats from Patrick Jenkins. Ms. Bailey suggested next year that on the night of the event a voucher will be issued that can be redeemed at 		

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	 Volunteers – The committee members agreed that the number of volunteers for that night worked out fine. The volunteers in the parking lot were especially helpful. One suggestion was to possibly start the event earlier next year, starting at 3:00 PM and lasting to 6:00 PM or 7:00 PM. 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Homeless Count Report	Kathy McGaha next reported on the Homeless Count Report. Ms. McGaha passed out handouts for the committee members to review and discuss.		
	Ms. McGaha reviewed the first form – <i>North Carolina</i> <i>Point-in-Time Count Reporting Form.</i> This first page covers the households with dependent children, the households without dependent children and the different defined subpopulations. The second page defines who is Imminently Homeless, Precariously Housed and Housed & At-Risk. The third page and fourth page cover the sheltered count in Macon County.		
	Ms. McGaha then reviewed the second hand-out titled – 2009 Point-in-Time Count: Balance of State. This form had numbers from most of the counties in North Carolina. Ms. McGaha questioned why Macon County had separate county numbers and then was also listed in a seven county area. Ms. Case will check on this issue.	Kristi Case will check on the numbers regarding the seven county area which included Macon County.	
	Rhonda Blanton also passed out a handout that covered the homeless count in Buncombe County. The newspaper article reported that the preliminary data suggested that the homeless population in Buncombe County had declined.		
	Ms. McGaha next asked the committee members what this committee wanted to do with the information collected and how this committee might use this information to help members of this community. Ms.		
	McGaha suggested to the committee members to hold a special meeting and discuss this in detail. The committee members could then develop action plans.		
Other Items for Discussion	Other Items for Discussion: • Robby Holland informed the committee members about the upcoming Operation Medicine Drop		

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	being held on Saturday, March 20 th . Mr. Holland said the Macon County Sheriff's Office, the Franklin Police Department and the Highlands Police Department will be collecting unwanted or out of date prescriptions. Mr. Holland said the locations are K-Mart, Wal-Mart and in front of the Highlands Pharmacy. The time frame will be 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM. Mr. Holland said they hope to conduct another collection date, possibly during the Macon County Fair.
