	Jennifer Garrett informed the committee members that there was a homeless problem in the Nantahala community. As school nurse, Ms. Garrett has become aware of students who are living in houses with no utilities, in tents, or in temporary situations in other households.		
	Kristi Case next explained the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) to the committee members. Ms. Case stated that this program is to provide assistance for homelessness prevention to households who might otherwise become homeless and to provide assistance to rapidly re-house individuals who are homeless.		
	Ms. Case explained that North Carolina will receive approximately \$22 million in HPRP funds, of which around \$4 million will be allocated to administration

	currently considering building solutions. Ms. McCoy		
	stated once this building situation is resolved, 40 slots		
	will be available. Ms. McCoy said currently they have		
	90 names on their waiting list.
