Welcome and Approval of	Kathy McGaha welcomed everyone to today's meeting		
Minutes	of the Strengthening Families Committee. Ms. McGaha		
	stated that due to the content of today's meeting the

Introductions	Ms. McGaha asked everyone to introduce themselves		
	and tell what organization they represented.		
HUD Funds	Kathy McGaha updated the committee members on the		
	HUD Funds. Ms. McGaha said that both MPP and		
	CARENET decided not to apply for these funds, but that		
	The Children's Home did apply. Ms. McGaha said the		
	awarding of the funds will be announced in September.		
	Ms. McGaha (reporting for Rebecca Barboff) said these		
	funds would help establish a youth homeless program for		
	Macon and surrounding counties. Ms. McGaha said this		
	program would help youth who are aging out of the		
	system. Ms. McGaha also said this program could also		
	help runaways in our area.		
Counting the Homeless	Kathy McGaha asked the committee members if they had		
	done their homework assignment of reading the handout		
	from the last meeting titled – A Guide to Counting		
	Unsheltered Homeless People, before leading them into a		
	discussion on counting homeless people in Macon		
	County.		
	Ms. McGaha stated that the next Point-in-Time Count		
	should be conducted within the last seven days of		
	January 2010. Ms. McGaha explained that there are		
	several ways to count the homeless:		
	Sheltered Count – Contact agencies that deal with		
	homeless people and obtain their numbers. This		

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	would include emergency shelters and transitional housing. Unsheltered Count – These numbers would include "street people" and others who are at locations like soup kitchens, food banks, or emergency rooms. Combination Count – These numbers would reflect both sheltered and unsheltered counts. The committee members discussed the best way to obtain these numbers in our county. The committee members were in agreement that offering a meal in a location like CARENET would provide the best location and opportunity to conduct this count. Locations in Highlands and Nantahala would also have to be considered. The committee members agreed that one of the biggest issues to get homeless people to the suggested location was transportation. Jane Kimsey will contact Kim Angel about use of the Transit buses for this purpose. Ms. Kimsey will also ask Ms. Angel to the next meeting. The committee members also considered if the 2010 U.S. Census could be filled by the homeless during this count. Derek Roland will check with the Andrea Robel if the census forms could be obtained early enough to do this. Rhonda Blanton will get a copy of the 2010 U.S. Census form for Ms. McGaha	Jane Kimsey will contact Kim Angel about use of the Transit buses and invite her to this committee's next meeting. Derek Roland will contact Andrea Robel about obtaining census forms to use during this count. Rhonda Blanton will give Kathy McGaha a copy of the 2010 U.S. Census form.	FOLLOW-UP
