AMENDED PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

MACON COUNTY

NORTH CAROLINA

Section 1. Pursuant to Macon County Ordinance Chapter 31 and Chapter 166 of the North Carolina General Statutes and the specific authority granted pursuant to NCGS §166A-19.22, on September 29, 2024 I determined that a State of Emergency as defined in County Ordinance 31-3 existed in the County of Macon as a result of the heavy rainfall and gusty winds that affected our region.

Section 2. I, therefore, proclaimed the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of Macon.

Section 3. The September 29, 2024 Proclamation of a State of Emergency, and everything contained within it, continues to be in place in Macon County.

Section 4. I hereby waive tipping and transfer fees at the landfill and the transfer station in Highlands for disaster related vegetative and other debris.

Section 5. This amended proclamation shall become effective on October 3, 2024 at 08:00 AM.
