- 1. <u>Board Oath of Office</u>: Macon County Clerk of Court Shauna Lamb swore in the Macon County Board of Elections members for 2023-25. They are Chair Kathy Tinsley, Democratic members Lynne Garrison, and Jeff Gillette, and Republicans John Vanhook and Gary Dills.
- 2. <u>Minutes from 10 May 2023 and 23 May 2023:</u> Ms. Garrison made a motion to accept both minutes as written. Mr Gillette seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved. Attachments 1 and 2
- 3. One Stop Plan for Municipal Elections: Mr. Dills made a motion to accept the One Stop Plan which calls for open polls during the period 19 October to 4 November, from 8 AM to 7:30 PM (Monday through Friday) and on Saturdays form 8 AM to 3 PM.
