Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 5 PM.

- 1. <u>Minutes from 13 September 2023:</u> Mr. Gillette made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Mr. Vanhook seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved. Attachments 1
- 2. <u>Absentee Plan for March 2024 Primary Election:</u> Mr. Dills made a motion to accept the One Stop Plan which calls for open polls during the period 15 February to 2 March 2024 from 8 AM to 7:30 PM (Monday through Friday) and on Saturdays from 8 AM to 3 PM at the Carpenter Center and the Highlands Civic Center. The Director opened each envelope with the Board observing. Mr. Dills and Ms. Garrisson observed Ms. Fritts as she opened the polling station. The counter read zero. Ms. Garrison entered the ballots into the polling station with Mr. Dills observing. Ms. Fritts closed the polls with the counter reading four. Ms. Fritts closed the case holding the polling station and sealed it with a seal numbered 5838994.

7. <u>Adjourn:</u> Ms. Garrison made a motion to adjourn until 7 November 2023 at 5 PM. Mr Gillette seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved. The Board adjourned at 6 PM.
