- Early voting will begin April 23rd-May 9th open last Saturday-May 9th, 2020
- Lynda Bennett only got <u>23%</u> of the votes cast. A candidate must get more than <u>30%</u> in a Primary Election to be considered a winner and because Bennett did not do so, she will be facing Madison Cawthorn on May 12th
- Absentee by mail will begin on Saturday, March 28, 2020-Tuesday, May 5, 2020
- At this time both early voting sites will be open for the second Primary:
 - o The Community Building, 1288 Georgia Road, Franklin, NC 28734
 - o The Highlands Civic Center, 600 N. 4th Street, Highlands, NC 28741
 - o The hours for both locations will be 8:00am-7:30pm
- Voter ID will not be required for the second Primary
- No new registrations are permitted until after the second Primary
- No changes to a party affiliation until after the second Primary
- If a voter is unaffiliated and voted in the Primary and voted other than Republican, they cannot vote Republican in the second Primary
- <u>Unaffiliated voters who voted a Republican ballot in the first Primary may only vote a Republican ballot in the second Primary</u>
- Unaffiliated voters who voted a Democratic or Libertarian ballot in the first Primary are not eligible to vote in the second Primary
- Unaffiliated voters who did not vote in the first Primary may vote in the second Primary and will be issued the Republican Primary ballot
- If a voter did not vote in the first Primary and they are Republican, they can vote in the second Primary
- Canvass of the 2nd Primary will be held in the Board of Elections office on Friday, May 22nd at 11:00am
- Filing for School Board and Soil & Water will begin on Monday, June 8that noon thru Thursday, July 2nd at noon. Filing fee is \$5.00
- Seats up: District 4 at large-Jim Breedlove-current-4 year term, District 3-Melissa Evans-current-4 year term, District 1-Stephanie McCall-current-4 year term, and Soil & Water-Matt Mason-current-4 year term
- The General Election will be held Tuesday, November 3rd, 2020
- Absentee by mail begins September 4th, 2020-October 27th, 2020
- Voter registration deadline is October 9th, 2020
- One-Stop Early voting will begin Thursday, October 15th, 2020-October 31st, 2020
 - Early voting locations: The Community Building, 1288 Georgia Rd. Franklin, NC 28734 and The Highlands Civic Center, 600 N. 4th St. Highlands, NC 28741
- The hours at both sites will be Monday-Friday 8:00am-7:30pm and both will be open on the last Saturday, October 31st, 2019 8:00am-3:00pm. October 31st will be the last day to vote early
