NOTICE: PER MAY 1, 2020's update this page has been updated with new information in regards to the Republican 2<sup>nd</sup> Primary Election scheduled for June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020.

- **Absentee by mail** will began May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and ends June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- Early voting will begin Thursday, June 4, 2020-Saturday, June 20th, 2020
- There will be **2 locations** for early voting:
  - Highlands Civic Center-600 N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Highlands, NC 28741
    Hours for this location will be Monday-Friday 8:00am-7:30pm and open the last Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 8:00am-3:00pm
  - Robert Carpenter Community Building-1288 Georgia Road, Franklin, NC 28734
     Hours for this location will be Monday-Friday 8:00am-5:00pm and open the last Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 8:00-3:00pm
- Voter ID is NOT required for this Election
- NO new voter registrations are permitted until after the second primary is completed
- NO changes to party affiliations are permitted to a voters record until after the second primary is completed
- If a voter is registered as an Unaffiliated and voted a Republican ballot in the 1<sup>st</sup> Primary Election, (March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020) they are permitted to vote in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Primary Election
- If a voter is registered Democrat and voted in the 1st Primary Election, they are not permitted to vote in this Election
- Early voting will end on Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 3:00pm at both locations
- There will be **NO** voting at the Macon County Courthouse on Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 or on Election Day (June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020). To cast your ballot on Election Day <u>June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020</u>) the following Precincts will be combined into 1 location:
- North Franklin, South Franklin, East Franklin, Iotla, Union, Millshoal, Ellijay, Sugarfork, Smithbridge, Cartoogechaye, Burningtown and Cowee. All voters who are eligible will vote at the Robert Carpenter Community Building
- Highlands and Flats Precincts-voters who are eligible will vote at the Highlands Civic Center
- Voters in the Nantahala Precinct will vote at the EMS building located at 1096 Junaluska Rd, Topton, NC 28781 as usual

<u>Absentee Board Meetings</u> will be held on Tuesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, June 16<sup>th</sup> and June 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5:00pm per g.s. Meetings will be held in the Board of Elections Office and are open to the public. Board meeting minutes are also located on the website for your convenience.
