Child Health Clinics are held monthly for children 2 months of age to 21 years of age. The Child Health Clinic provides well child screenings, kindergarten ,daycare and sports physicals. It is recommended that all children have regular well child screenings to ensure optimal health, growth and development. The following is the Macon County Public Health Center's recommended schedule for well child screenings:

- 2 months
- 4 months
- 6 months
- 12 months
- 15 months (this screening may be done at 9 months instead)
- 18 months
- 2 years
- 3 years
- 4 years
- 5 years
- 6 years
- Then every three years to age 21.

During a Child Health Clinic appointment, your child will receive a comprehensive screening which includes the following services:

- Health history
- Review of immunizations (may include a link to the immunization page)
- Physical exam
- Hearing and vision screening
- Developmental screening
- Assessment of growth
- Health, safety, and nutritional counseling
- Laboratory testing (hemoglobin, urinalysis, blood lead level)

**Cost:** Macon County Public Health Center accepts all types of insurance including Medicaid and NC Health Choice. However, if your insurance doesn't cover the cost of a well child screening, the cost for the Child Health Clinic will be based on a sliding fee scale.

**Appointments:** To schedule an appointment for your child, call the Macon County Public Health Center at 349-2081. For your convenience, we offer morning appointments, as well as early and late afternoon appointments.
