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
YRBSS Macon County - 2002

- A National School-Based Survey developed by the Center of Disease Control
- Conducted to assess the prevalence of health risk behaviors of youth
- Strict Confidentiality
- Voluntary

YRBSS Macon County - 2002


- Administered April & May of 2002
- Total of 1,594 respondents of 2,224 enrolled students a (71.7% response rate).
- High School Total=885, M=437, F=443
- Middle School Total=709, M=361, F=347
- Topics: dietary habits, physical activity, tobacco, alcohol and drug use, violence, sexual behavior, safety, and depression

% of Students Who Eat 3 or More Servings Per Day




% of Students Who Drink 3 or More Servings Per Day








HS High Impact = 20 min. for 3 or more out of 7 days

MS Low Impact = 30 min. for 3 or more out of 7 days


of Days/Week in PE Class




TV & Computer/Video Game Usage 3 or More Hours on an Avg. School Day







"How often do you wear your seatbelt when riding in a car?"



"Have you ever ridden in a car driven by someone who had been drinking alcohol?"



"During the past 30 days, on how many days did you carry a weapon such as a gun, knife, or club?"

- 0 days = 62%
- > 1 days = 38% (> 6 days = 25%)
- HS exceeds state average by 100%

"During the past 30 days, on how many days did you carry a weapon such as a gun, knife, or club on school property?"

- 0 days = 74%
- > 1 days = 26% (> 6 days = 16%)
- HS exceeds state average (5%) by 425%
- MS exceeds state average (5%) by 100%


Also higher than state averages:

- Injured in fight, treated (past 12 months) =100% (3% vs. 6%)
- Threatened/injured with weapon (≥ 1 day on school property) =51% (8% vs. 12%)
- Physical fight (≥ 1 day on school property)
 =46% (11% vs. 16%)


However, Macon County Students on average feel safer...

- HS, violence is a problem at school=14%
 (below state average by 48%)
- HS, harassment/bullying is a problem at school=28% (below state average by 12%)
- MS, violence is a problem at school=27% (below state average by 10%)



During the past 12 months, have you...?

- Seriously considered (ideation) suicide=22% HS (197), 22% MS (158)
- Made a plan (gesture)=16% HS (139)
- Actually attempted=17% HS (151)

■ 82% have not considered suicide

Of those who claim they actually attempted suicide (17%)...

■ 1 time =59% (90)


 \blacksquare 2 or 3 times = 14% (20)

■ 4 or 5 times =11% (14)


 $\ge 6 \text{ times}$ =18% (27)

* HS exceeds state average for seriously considering suicide by 25%


"Have you ever tried cigarette smoking, even one or two puffs?"



"During the past 30 days, how did you usually get your own cigarettes?"




"During the past 30 days, on how many days did you use smokeless tobacco?"






Never – 78% HS, 85% MS

Cigarettes and Alcohol 1 or More Days on High School Property




How old were you the first time...? High School

How old were you the first time...? Middle School




■ Cigarettes■ Alcohol

■ Marijuana


Never – 64% Cigarettes, 52% Alcohol, 80% Marijuana

Marijuana 1 or More Times on High School Property







Yes, I have been offered illegal drugs on school property.




Yes, drugs are a problem at my school.




During your life, how many times have you...? **High School**

"How old were you when you had sexual intercourse for the first time?"



Of high school students having sex...

- \geq 1 partner = 49% (with 8% reporting have \geq 6 partners)
- Prior alcohol/drugs = 29%
- **■** Condom use = 39%
 - (former Surgeon General fired over this issue)

"How many times have you been pregnant or gotten someone pregnant?"

- \ge 1 or more times = HS 6% (53), MS 3% (21)
- Not Sure = HS 3% (30), MS 2% (14)


The Good News...

- High School
 - Adults home after school
 - Less smokers 20+ days of prior month
 - Helmet use on motorcycles/bikes
 - Less perception that violence is a problem at school
 - Less avoidance of school for feeling unsafe
 - Less harassing/bullying at school


The Good News...

- Middle School
 - Less overweight/less at risk
 - Wearing helmets on bikes
 - Less perception that violence is a problem at school
 - Less stolen/damaged property
