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	examine specific topics, discuss them in-depth and make recommendations of goals and objectives to the planning board.		
	 Mr. Roland listed the subcommittees: Public Input Committee Health/Seniors/Child Care Education/Recreation Housing/Transportation Economic Development/Public Services Land Use/Environment 		
	Ms. Southard then passed around several handouts she had gathered with information for Senior Friendly Communities. Ms. Southard asked the committee members to review these handouts and discuss if this committee could use any of them or duplicate what they contain for our use.		
	After a group discussion, the committee members agreed to collect information that could possibly be used and bring it to the next meeting. Ms. Southard stated the information would be more helpful if it was directly related to Macon County.
